HOW TO PLAN A NNO PARTY IN 15 DAYS



1. Make a list of neighbors on your street.
2. Send out email invitations (we will provide you with a flyer).
3. Register your party at orlando.gov/police.
4. Request a donation letter from the OPD's Neighborhood Watch.
5. Use the letter to request donations for food, drinks, and supplies (plates, cups, napkins, etc.).
6. Ask families to donate items like food, drinks, or fun activities (balls, blankets, etc.).
7. Plan kids' activities like face painting, a sidewalk chalk contest, or a slip-n-slide.
8. Organize ice-breaker activities to help neighbors get to know each other.
